N. Access to Library Building

Library keys will be maintained and distributed by the Library Director. No employee under the age of 18 years old will be issued a key to the outside doors of the Library. The following will have Library Building outside door and Director's office keys: Library Director, Library employees given access by the Director, Goddard City Clerk, Goddard City Police Chief, Goddard City Manager, Goddard Public Works department and Library cleaning attendant.

- Any employee entering the Library after hours must notify the Director before they enter

Any employee that visits the Library as a patron, (not within scheduled work hours):

- Must enter within the Library's regularly scheduled open hours
- Employees in the Library as a patron are not allowed in any work area, i.e. in the vault area or behind the checkout counter.

Building use is limited to library sponsored programs with a paid library staff being in attendance. Library space including the small meeting room may not be used for profit. No afterhours gatherings are permitted unless it is advertised as free and open to the public.

F. Exhibits and Displays - Exhibits and displays in the library are authorized by the Director and the Board on the basis of whether the exhibit or display supports the goals of the Library. Staff will not remove books from displays that they may not agree with or like seeing.

Individuals must sign a "Waiver of Liability" in order to display or exhibit items. If an item or items that are part of an exhibit or display are lost, damaged or stolen while on library premises, the "Waiver of Liability" (see appendix) provides that the Library will not be held responsible for the \$250 deductible for such loss, damage or theft.

G. Other Library Services – No individuals or organizations may distribute printed or other materials, solicit signatures for petitions, and conduct surveys, tutoring, hold classes or otherwise use library property non-library purposes.

To check out items:

All patrons must have their library card or appropriate ID which includes: a Kansas State Driver's License, KS auto registration, a personal checkbook with printed current address, a post marked item of mail to one's current address, or another official document with one's current name and address.

From the State Library:

All Kansas residents may use the library without charge. All Kansas residents 18 or over are entitled to a library card by completing a written application form. Any card holder may check out circulating materials on presentation of their library card. If a person does not have their card with them at time of checkout, the person must have identification.

- As the world changes, so will we. The struggle for social justice is ongoing. We accept the principle of non-closure and acknowledge that our understanding and awareness is constantly evolving.

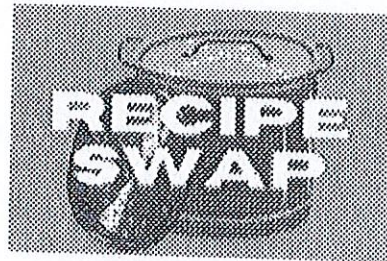
